The Rosslare Community Development Association is delighted to announce the completion of our new building at **Grove House**. The previous site had fallen into serious disrepair, with a collection of buildings of varying sizes that no longer met the needs of our community. Thanks to the excellent work of **Austin Codd Groundworks**, we now have a modern, purpose-built facility that will serve Rosslare for many years to come.

The new building includes the **Grove Room**, a general-purpose space available for hire and already in use by groups such as the Women's Shed, board meetings, and craft groups. Alongside this, a dedicated Men's Shed workshop has been created, connected to bathroom facilities and a canteen, providing a welcoming and practical space for members. The building also houses a large garage and workshop for the maintenance team at Rosslare Community and Sports Centre, where they can store and service the mowers used to maintain the village. This area is equipped with workbenches and its own canteen to support their daily operations. At the end of the building, a shared storage unit has been provided for the athletics clubs St Paul's and Menapians, ensuring they have secure and accessible facilities for their equipment.

The project was part-funded by the **Department of Rural and Community Development and Pobal under the Community Centre Investment Fund (CCIF)** programme, with a grant of €130,625.00 supporting Phase 3 of the development. Phases 1 and 2 were funded directly by the RCDA through a bank loan and the tireless fundraising efforts of our community. Events such as Family Bingo, SummerFest, and raffles played a vital role in raising the necessary funds.

We are incredibly grateful to everyone who contributed, whether through donations, participation in events, or volunteering. Your support has been instrumental in achieving this milestone and ensuring that Grove House will serve as a vibrant hub for the Rosslare community for generations to come.



In addition to the roof replacement, we are excited to announce further development plans for 2026:
